Too many conflicts may result in one not being cast. Rehearsal attendance problems after being cast may result in actors being dropped from the cast or having their roles changed to something smaller.

All cast members must be available for all the rehearsals during Tech Week and all performances.

List of Characters:

Elinor: (Lead) (F) Eldest and Very sensible and emotionally controlled daughter of Mrs Dashwood. More sensible than her mother. Actress needs to be (F) between age of 20-35 (or pass as that age)

Marianne: (Lead) (F) ... 2nd and very emotional daughter of Mrs. Dashwood. Actress needs to be (F) between age of 17-30 (or pass as that age)

Mrs Dashwood: (F) .. Mother of 3 daughters, recently widowed, displaced from her home by her step sons wife. Desperately wishes for her daughters to be taken care of and well to do .. Actress needs to be (F) between age of 30-60 (or pass as that age)

Colonel Brandon: (M) .. Gentleman that has served in the Army, lives in Devonshire, is attracted to Marianne. Actor needs to be (M) between age of 30-60 (or pass as that age)

John Willoughby: (M) .. Gentleman, very much dependent on his Aunt's inheritance for a living. Loves Marianne but won't leave his money for her, also a cad in other ways. Actor needs to be (M) between the ages of 20-30

Edward Ferrars: (M) .. Brother of Mrs Fanny Dashwood

Mrs Jennings: (F) Mother -in-law to Sir John Middleton. Very gossipy and often matchmaking. Actress can be aged 40-80 (or pass as that age)

Sir John Middleton: (M) - 2nd cousin to Mrs Dashwood, allows the Dashwood ladies to rent his cottage actor needs to be (M) age between 40-80.

Ms. Lucy Steele: (F) *old friend of Edwards actress should be (F) and similar in age to Elinor*

Mr John Dashwood: (M) - Step son of Mrs Dashwood's late husband, the heir of Norwood estate actor (M) aged between 25-40

Mrs. Fanny Dashwood: (F) .. Wife to Mr. John Dashwood. Mother of a small child, very selfish

Margaret: (F) – youngest daughter of Mrs Dashwood. Very young, somewhat a tom boy, lacks social sense age 12+

Mrs. Palmer: (F) *daughter to Mrs Jennings. Actress (F) aged 20-50 (or pass as that age)*

Mr. Palmer: (M) husband to Mrs Palmer actor (M) aged 30-50.

MISS GREY: (F) – Willoughby's Fiancée in 2nd Act (F) similar in age to Elinor

Thomas: (M) servant to the Dashwoods. (M) 20+

Betsy: (F) servant to the Dashwoods (F) 20+

PERKS, THE FOOTMAN, Servant 1: Either Gender 14+

Servant 2: Probably Female. 14+

Messenger, Servant 3: Either Gender 14+

DR HARRIS: Doctor to Mr. Palmer either gender 20+
