Rehearsal attendance problems after being cast may result in actors being dropped from the cast or having their roles changed to something smaller.



Virtually every cast member will be assigned to an ensemble group for musical numbers in which they are not singing as their featured character.

The purpose of this form is to help the music director assign vocal parts in a way that supports each performer's comfort, confidence, and the overall sound of the ensemble.

There are no "right" or "wrong" answers. Many fantastic soloists and principal performers may find harmony singing challenging, and no one will be excluded from any part based on their comfort level with harmony.

Please also note that we will be using a *flexible harmony* approach rather than strict SATB. For example, someone whose natural vocal range is bass may be assigned to the melody group and sing the melody in a comfortable octave. Likewise, a soprano who enjoys challenging harmony may be assigned to a vocal line typically designated for altos.
